Cross border at Niagara Falls

Cross the border into Ontario and take Falls Avenue to highway 420, also called Niagara Veterans Memorial Highway.

Follow 420 to the Q.E.W., which stands for Queen Elizabeth Way. Take the Q.E.W north to Hamilton. Just past Hamilton you go over a big bridge and then the Q.E.W. curves east towards Toronto.

Stay on the Q.E.W. Just past the town of Oakville you will take 403 north to highway 401. The 403 cutoff is right by the big Ford plant on the right side. Take the 403 to the 401.

Go east on highway 401 to highway 400. Head north on highway 400. You will drive all the way to the city of Barrie.

Just north of Barrie highway 400 ends. It splits into highway 69 and highway 11. Take highway 69 north to Sudbury. Make sure you fill up your gas tank at the first gas station you see because there are very few gas stations and coffee shops on this road.

Just before you reach Sudbury take highway 17 west. Highway 17 is also called the Trans Canada Highway. Take highway 17 all the way to the town of Iron Bridge.

When you reach Iron Bridge go north on hwy 556 until you reach highway 129. Turn right onto 129 (north). Have your camera ready because the scenery on this road is gorgeous. You take 129 north towards Chapleau. About 200 yards before you reach highway 101, there will be a big Moose Horn Lodge sign. Turn left on Sheppard Morse Road and follow a few hundred yards to the lodge.
